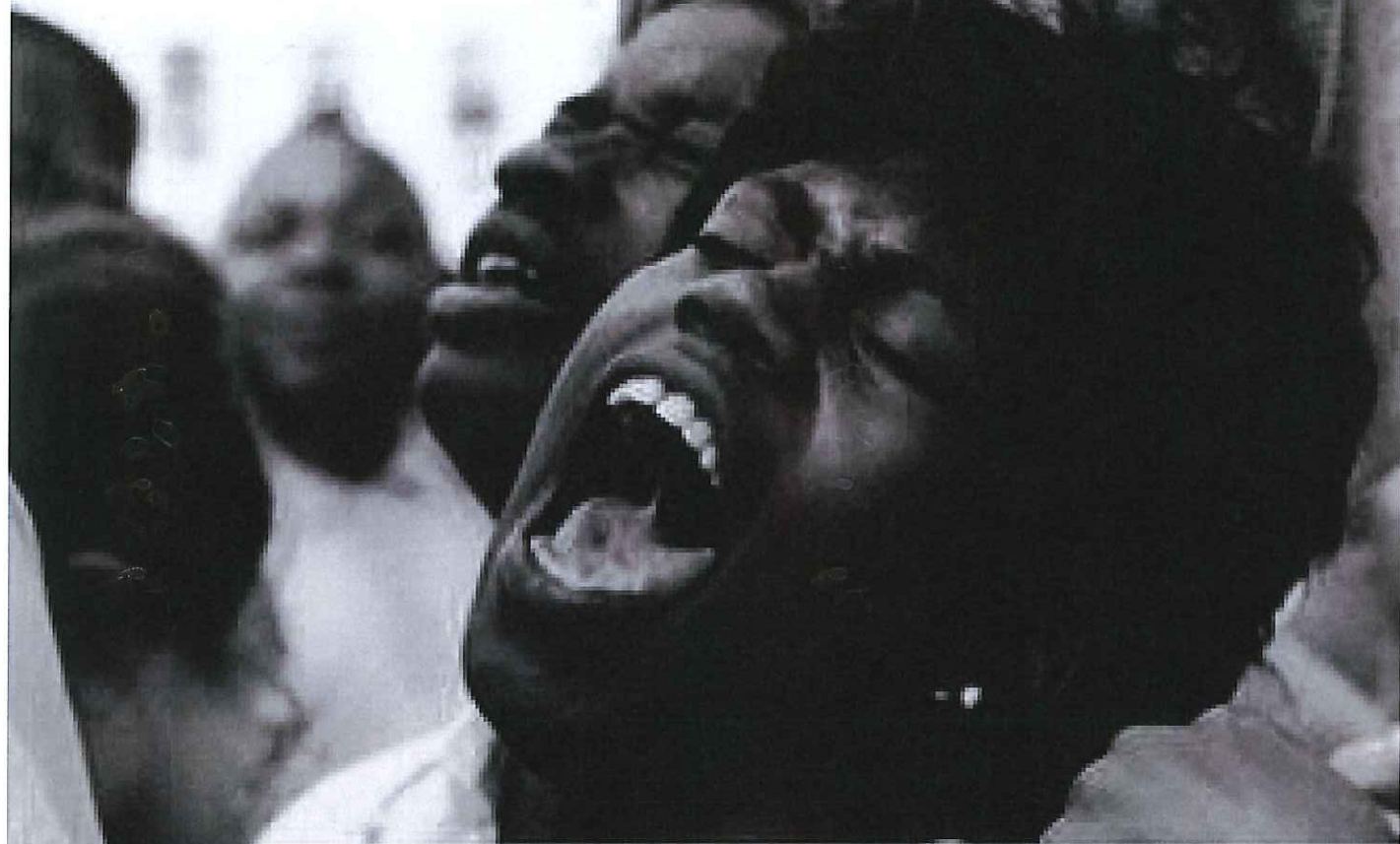

Attached you will find the questions for this Wednesday's panel. The first five questions are specific to certain panelist. The rest of the questions are for the whole panel. There will also be questions from the audience.
